AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN THE PAYMENT TO MEMBERS OF THE VARIOUS BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS OF THE VILLAGE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council previously approved payment of compensation to members appointed to and serving on certain boards and commissions of the Village pursuant to Ordinance 1999-19 and Ordinance 2002-16, and

WHEREAS, Council desires to revised the amount of compensation paid to members of the Planning Commission, Personnel Review Board, Board of Zoning Appeals, Architectural Review Board and Tax Review Board for their timely attendance at meetings of said Boards and Commissions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HIGHLAND HILLS, OHIO:

Section 1: Ordinances 1999-99 and 2002-16 are hereby amended such that, effective February 1, 2024, compensation for all members of the Planning Commission, Personnel Review Board, Board of Zoning Appeals, Architectural Review Board and Tax Review Board shall be at the rate of \$50.00 per meeting. Each member shall only be entitled to such compensation after certifying that said member physically appeared at and attended a prior meeting of the respective Board or Commission, at which said board transacted the business to which the person/member was assigned to complete pursuant to the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Highland Hills, Ohio. The Finance Director is authorized to issue payment to each such member whose attendance was verified in writing by the Chair of said Board or Commission.

<u>Section 2:</u> Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an orderly meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were conducted in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to provide for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the

Village of Highland Hills, and for the reason that it is immediately necessary to revise the payment to be made to such members of the aforementioned boards or commissions of the Village, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
