#### **ORDINANCE NO. 2024-20**

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS OF FUNDS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES OF THE VILLAGE OF HIGHLAND HILLS FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2024, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, O.R.C. 5705.38(A) requires that Council pass an Ordinance on an annual basis on or before April 1 appropriating funds to provide for the current expenses of the Village during the entire 2024 calendar year, and same shall be certified to the County Auditor or County Fiscal Officer.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HIGHLAND HILLS, OHIO:

<u>Section 1:</u> To provide for the current expenses of the Village of Highland Hills for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2024 and ending December 31, 2024, the following sums are hereby appropriated according to the fund descriptions and summary of items as set forth in Schedule A, the appropriations budget, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein fully by reference.

<u>Section 2</u>: The Finance Director is authorized to draw warrants on the Village Treasury for the amount appropriated in this Ordinance, whenever claims are presented, properly approved by the Mayor, head of the department or by the Chief Officer of a Board or Commission, for which the indebtedness was incurred.

<u>Section 3:</u> That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Ordinance to the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer.

Section 4: Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an orderly meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were conducted in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 5:</u> This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to provide for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Highland Hills, and for the reason it is necessary to provide adequate funds to pay current

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expenses of the Village operations for the calendar year in compliance with ORC 5705.38 and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-third (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
