**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 105.06(h) ENTITLED FEES IN THE
STREETS, UTILITIES AND PUBLIC SERVICES CODE,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, The Village of Highland Hills provides quality Emergency Medical Services (EMS) and has not upgraded the rates charged for said services in several years; and

WHEREAS, The Village recently contracted with Great Lakes Billing, who after a review of the EMS program, has recommended an increase in the types of services to be billed and the amounts to be billed for each service; and

WHEREAS, This Council desires to increase the rates charged in accordance with the recommendations of Great Lakes Billing, as further set forth hereinbelow.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HIGHLAND HILLS, OHIO:

Section 1: That Section 105.06(h) entitled Fees In The Streets, Utilities And Public Services Code be and hereby is amended to increase the rates charged for EMS services and shall read as follows:

(h) Services rendered by the Village Emergency Medical Service (EMS) for residents and nonresidents (per person, per call):

	<u>Residents/Non Residents</u>
Basic life support (BLS)	\$550.00 650.00
Advanced life support I (ALSI)	\$750.00 800.00
Advanced Life Support II (ALSII)	\$850.00 1100.00
Mileage charge	\$14.00 16.50 per loaded mile
TNT (Treated not transported)	\$0 360.00

Section 2: Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an orderly meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were conducted in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to provide for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Highland Hills, and for the reason that said ordinance is immediately necessary for the orderly operation of the Village Fire Department, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
